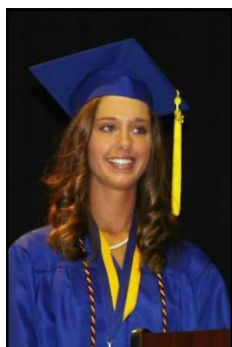

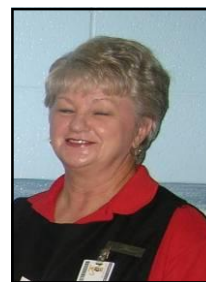

## Two Cowpens Middle School Teachers Recognized

Denise Pennington, a special education teacher at Cowpens Middle School, has been elected state president-elect for 2008-2010 for Alpha Delta Kappa, an international honorary organization for women educators. She will assume the role of state president in 2010 and serve 2 years in that capacity.

Pennington has been an active member of ADK since 1996. Pennington has taught a total of 29 years, the last 14 years at Cowpens Middle School.

Christine Phillips, also a special education teacher at CMS, was named the South Carolina Alpha Delta Kappa *Excellence in Education Award*

recipient. This award recognizes members of Alpha Delta Kappa for their outstanding contributions to education. Phillips has taught for 35 years, all at Cowpens Middle School.

Alpha Delta Kappa is dedicated to educational excellence, altruism and world understating.

## End of Year ABCD Award Winners Announced

Angie Jarecki, special education teacher at Cowpens Middle School, and Thomas Gist, Head Custodian at the Middle School of Pacolet, were selected as the 4th quarter winners of the Above and Beyond the Call of Duty (ABCD) Award.

The nomination for Mrs. Jarecki complimented her multi-tasking abilities and dedication to the students and parents at CMS.



Her nomination further read that she is "a remarkable individual who is always ready to rise above and beyond the call of duty when needed." She began her career in District 3 nine years ago as a teacher assistant for special education classes at Cannons Elementary. Jarecki then pursued a teaching position with

CMS, working with resource and self-contained students. She has written the Red Carpet Application for Cowpens Middle School, painted several murals and inspiring words in the hallways, received a \$250.00 grant to the Champions of the Environment for a flower garden for the front of the school and worked with the school administration on beautifying main office and teachers lounge area. Jarecki also co-sponsors the FCA club and has helped to raise over \$800.00 for Relay for Life.

Thomas Gist believes in making a good first impression, and his work at Middle School of Pacolet has done just that for over 15 years. As visitors tour the school, their first comments consistently praise the cleanliness of the school. It is not uncommon for visitors to remark that they can see their reflection in the cafeteria floor.

Gist's nomination highlighted his diligence and dedication to his responsibilities and duties. The nomination

read, "He is the first person in the building each day, arriving at 5:30 a.m. to check and make sure that everything is in order. It is not unusual for him to pull two shifts if the second shift person has to be absent. In the past three years, he has missed less than one week of work. The dedication to his work and the pride that he takes in maintaining the cleanliness of the building are evident in every area."



Teachers have commented that requests for assistance are handled quickly and efficiently. A teacher commented that he asked Gist for a screwdriver to put up a pencil sharpener and he was told not to worry. The next day the sharpener was up. This is just one example of Gist going Above and Beyond the Call of Duty.

## Broome Teacher Receives C-SPAN Fellowship

Gary Purinton, U.S. government teacher at Broome High School, has received a 2008 Middle and High School Teacher Fellowship through the C-SPAN Education Foundation.

Purinton was one of four innovative social studies teachers to receive one of these competitive fellowships. Fellows were chosen by a panel of C-SPAN representatives and evaluated based on their innovative use of C-SPAN programming, dedication to learning new technologies and commitment to professional development. Applicants are nominated by their local cable companies and are

required to demonstrate thorough knowledge of the network's philosophy and programming.

"I'm really excited about being selected this year, since it is an election year. Since I have been chosen, I feel like Jimmy Stewart in *Mr. Smith Goes to Washington*. I really believe that I can make a difference in my students' lives and the more real world experience I can bring to the classroom, the more effective citizens I can produce," said Purinton.

Purinton plans on running a blog during his time in Washington so his students may keep up with his activi-

ties. He plans on using his experiences in the classroom upon his return.

C-SPAN Classroom engages teachers and students in grades 6 through 12 in a variety of educational programs as part of the network's overall coverage of the presidential race.

# District Three Announces New Assignments

Spartanburg School District Three is pleased to announce that several administrators will assume new titles and two veteran educators will fill instructional coaching positions.

**Cindy Snead**, acting principal at Cowpens Elementary School since July 2007, has been named principal. Snead is a product of District Three schools. She has a bachelor's degree from the University of South Carolina Upstate, a master's degree in elementary education and a master's degree in educational leadership, both from Converse College.

**Dr. Eric Levitt** has been named Assistant Superintendent for Instructional and Personnel Services. Dr. Levitt has served as Director of Instructional and Personnel Services since Mary Seamon departed in September 2007.

Levitt joined the district staff in 1998 as a technology trainer. He has a bachelor's degree from James Madison University, a master's degree from Wake Forest University and a master's degree from Converse College. Levitt recently earned his doctorate in curriculum and instruction from the University of South Carolina.

**Janet Jennings** will become Acting Director of Pre-K – 5 Instruction for the 2008-2009 school year. Jennings fills the position that has been vacant since Dr. Eric Levitt assumed the Acting Assistant Superintendent position. Jennings has been working on a part-time basis since January helping to implement the district's early childhood reading initiative. She has a bachelor's degree from Clemson University and a master's degree from Clemson University with additional hours from Winthrop University and Furman University.

**Matthew Davis**, assistant principal at

Broome High School since 2006, has been named assistant principal at Cowpens Middle School. He replaces Dr. Robert Glenn who served as an interim assistant principal for the 2007-2008 school year.

Prior to serving as assistant principal, Davis taught biology, anatomy and physiology, chemistry, forensic science, physical science, and zoology for six years at Broome. He has a bachelor's degree from the University of South Carolina Upstate and a master's degree from Converse College.

During his teaching and administrative tenure, Davis was selected Teacher of the Year for 2003-2004 and went on to be selected as the District Teacher of the Year.

**Jermaine Greene**, assistant principal at Middle School of Pacolet since January 2007, has been named as an assistant principal at Broome High School, filling the position vacated by Matthew Davis. Prior to serving in his current position, Greene was an administrative intern and taught 9th grade math at Broome High School.

Greene earned his bachelor's degree from Furman University and his master's degree from Converse College. He has also completed the Spartanburg Potential Administrator's Academy in 2005.

Veteran elementary school teacher, **Luanne Bridges**, will assume a new role as a math coach for Spartanburg School District Three through a South Carolina State Department of Education grant. Under the grant, the math coach works with the goal of increasing student achievement in mathematics and in science.

Bridges earned a bachelor's degree from Limestone College and a master's degree from the University of South Carolina Upstate and Converse

College. She also earned National Board Certification in 2001.

For the 2000–2001 school year, Bridges served as Teacher of the Year for her school and was chosen the District Teacher of the Year.

New to District Three is **Renee Phillips** who joins the staff as a district wide reading specialist. Phillips has a master's degree from Converse College in administration and supervision and a master's degree from the College of Charleston in early childhood education.

After 10 years, Phillips is leaving Houston Elementary School in Spartanburg District Seven where she served as a South Carolina Reading Initiative Literacy Coach, Teacher Advancement Program (TAP) Master Teacher, and reading recovery teacher. Prior to moving to Spartanburg, she taught first and second grades in Kingsland, Georgia and reading recovery and self-contained emotionally handicapped in Summerville, SC.
