MINUTES

The Spartanburg District Three Board of Trustees met on Thursday, June 16, 2022, at 7:30 p.m. at the District Administration Building.

At 7:00 p.m., Chairman Jolley asked for a motion to go into executive session to discuss personnel and legal issues. Mr. Gossett made the motion and was seconded by Mrs. Gilmer. The vote was unanimous in favor.

At 7:30 p.m., Chairman Jolley asked for a motion to return to open session and stated that no action was taken while in executive session. Mr. Gossett made the motion and was seconded by Mrs. Gilmer. The vote was unanimous in favor.

Mr. Mack presented for approval to increase meal pricing up to the \$.10 cap for the 2022-23 school year. Mr. Gossett made a motion to approve and was seconded by Mrs. Dunn. The vote was 4-3 in favor.

Mr. Mack presented for approval the 2022-23 Multi-District Programs Budget. Mrs. Voelker made a motion to approve and was seconded by Mrs. Odom. The vote was unanimous in favor.

Mr. Mack presented for approval the 2022-23 Daniel Morgan Technology Center Budget. Mr. Gossett made a motion to approve and was seconded by Mrs. Odom. The vote was unanimous in favor.

Mr. Mack presented for approval the second reading of the 2022-23 Spartanburg School District Three Budget. Mrs. Gilmer made a motion to approve and was seconded by Mrs. Dunn. The vote was unanimous in favor.

Mr. Mack then presented for approval the transfer of the \$1,000,000 of fund balance that is assigned for Capital Projects to the Capital Project Fund. Mrs. Gilmer made a motion to approve and was seconded by Mr. Gossett. The vote was unanimous in favor.

Mr. Blackwood recommended for approval that Mrs. Hodge serve as the local education agency representative for Title I, II, III, and IV authorizing her to request funding on behalf of the district superintendent. Mrs. Gilmer made a motion to approve and was seconded by Mrs. Voelker. The vote was unanimous in favor.

Mr. Blackwood presented for approve a nominee from the District Three Board of Trustees to participate in an interview process with the SCSBA Nominating Committee for Region 14 Director. If selected, the nominee would go to the full SCSBA Board for final approval. Mr. Gossett made a motion to approve and was seconded by Mrs. Voelker. The vote was 5-2 opposed.

At 8:50 p.m., Mr. Logan made a motion to adjourn and was seconded by Mrs. Odom. The vote was unanimous in favor.
